#### Dear Friends,

It is a frightening time to be an immigrant in the United States. 2017 saw increased opposition from the government, a volatile legal and policy environment, increasing criminalization, and terror in immigrant communities. The children we serve, along with their families and communities, are facing more challenges now than at any time in recent memory. Safe Passage Project is not immune to these challenges, and we seem to face new and unpredictable obstacles at every step of the immigration process.



In these uncertain times, in 2017 we chose to grow bigger and stronger, equipping ourselves to meet these obstacles and those still ahead. We strengthened our small but mighty legal team and expanded our social work team. We led 33 training events, trained over 1,700 individuals on effective representation of immigrant children, and provided close mentorship to an army of more than 400 pro bono attorneys. With 160 new cases in 2017, we ended the year representing children in more than 700 cases. And we are winning those cases. Despite redoubled efforts to deport immigrants and narrow the path toward citizenship, we are proud to have maintained a success rate of over 80%.

It is with this context that we are so pleased to share with you this annual report. We could not have accomplished any of this without the steadfast support of our donors, the persistence of our pro bono attorneys, the leadership of 22 terrific staff, and most of all the resilience and strength of our young clients and their families.

As long as there are children facing the immigration process alone, we will continue to grow, to find creative ways to win their cases, and help them find a safe and stable future in the United States. To that end, as 2017 came to a close, Safe Passage Project adopted an inspiring and ambitious new goal — to grow to a caseload of 2,000 clients by 2020, ensuring that no unaccompanied children in NYC or Long Island must face immigration court without a lawyer.

On a personal note, 2017 was my first full year at Safe Passage and it has been the most rewarding time of my professional life. I am endlessly grateful to all our staff, partners and supporters - and especially to our inspiring clients who lead the way into a more tolerant and welcoming future.


### Safe Passage Project in Schools

In 2011, Safe Passage in Schools was created to serve the unmet needs of immigrant children enrolled in New York City public schools. Since May 2012, Safe Passage Project has worked closely with teachers, social workers, coaches, principals, and college advisors at public schools, such as Washington Heights Expeditionary Learning School (WHEELS), throughout Manhattan and the Bronx. Safe Passage Project holds confidential screenings at the schools to determine which students need assistance and provides the children with free representation.

In 2017, thanks to the generous support of The New World Foundation and Brooklyn Community Foundation, Safe Passage Project expanded its work in schools to serve immigrant children from all 5 boroughs of New York City. Now, Safe Passage Project is serving 50 undocumented students enrolled in NYC public schools with full legal representation through this program. According to one former client, "Safe Passage Project helped me understand that I was eligible to become a Legal Permanent Resident, and they made it happen. They represented me, and changed my life forever."

Sonia and her sister, Alisson, were both abandoned at an early age by their father. They eventually fled to the United States to escape the dangerous gangs that made it impossible to live safely in their neighborhood.

Through the help of their pro bono attorneys, both Sonia and Alisson secured guardianship and special findings orders. They both currently have a petition for Special Immigrant Juvenile Status pending so they can continue to seek safe and stable lives in the United States.




